

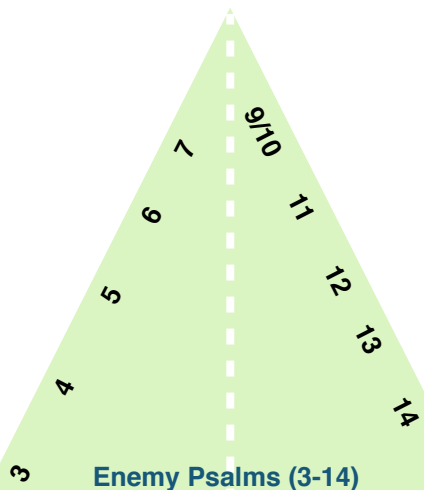
Book 1: Psalms 1-41

God has put his Son on the throne.

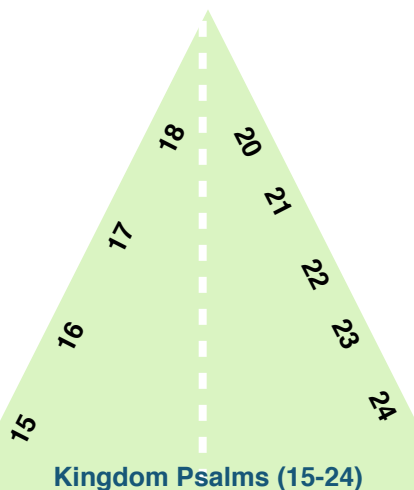

God has given his Word to man.

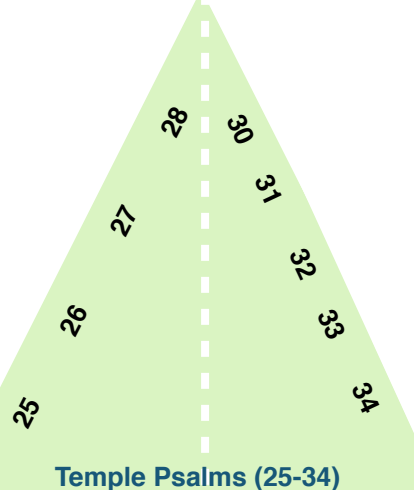

- 3:4 || 14:7 — Holy Hill of God

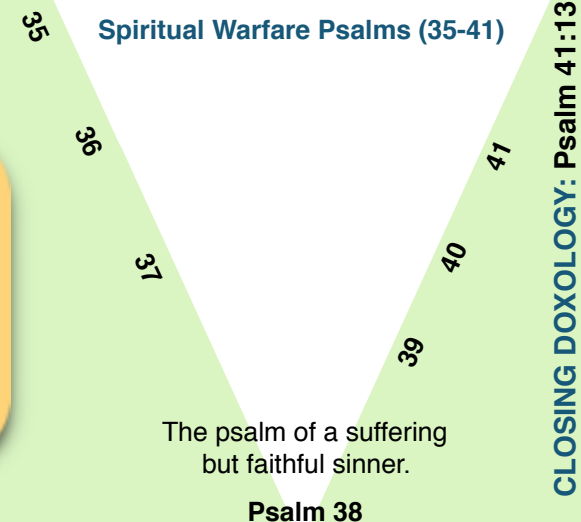
Hill #2: Ps 15-24

Hill #3: Ps 25-34

- Ps 25 || 34 — Acrostic Wisdom Psalms
- Ps 25:7,11,18 — Petitions Forgiveness
- Ps 29-30 — Provide God's Temple
- Ps 31:5 — Messianic Cry of Trust
- Ps 32:1-5 — Forgiveness is Granted
